We kicked off our Reconciliation activities with our excursion to Kings Park Naturescape. This was a fantastic opportunity for students to explore, play, and connect with the natural environment. Our children were outstanding throughout the visit, demonstrating curiosity, cooperation, and enthusiasm. Staff at Naturescape were very impressed with their positive engagement and behaviour. A sincere thank you to our parent and community helpers who supported the excursion, and to all our staff for their awesome work in making this experience such a success.

This week also includes participation in National Simultaneous Storytime. This is an annual event held across Australia where schools, libraries and communities read the same book at the same time, promoting the value of reading and literacy. This year's selected book is Luna Roo the Baller, and classes enjoyed sharing this story together as part of a nationwide celebration of storytelling.

Students will also be involved in activities for Reconciliation Week. This is an important time for learning, reflection, and building understanding of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures, histories, and contributions. Our classes will be engaging in age-appropriate experiences to support this learning.
