From the Principal's Desk

Great to see everyone back on board after the long weekend. We had a great lightning show to help pass the time. Week 6 and racing to the end of the term. Arrival times at all campuses are the same. Classes start at 8.30am. Doors open 15 minutes before school starts. We encourage all children to arrive then and not earlier for safety reasons. Staff in our early childhood areas set up outdoor equipment for the day's lessons so please keep clear of this. Each campus has a different finishing time. We are mindful that many families have pickup times for other children at other schools. It is important to be as prompt as possible to collect your child. After a busy day learning the last thing your little one wants is to be spending extra time at school.

It is great to see the healthy lunches and snacks that children are bringing to school. 'Healthy Eating' at school is important. We encourage eating healthy food and discourage eating cakes, chips and lollies. Please avoid these foods in lunch boxes. Each class also takes part in our "Crunch and Sip" program daily. We ask that all students bring along a piece of fruit or vegetable to share. We have severe nut allergies and each of our campuses are 'Allergy Aware". This means that you must not send any foods containing nuts to school with your child. This includes peanut paste, Nutella and snack/muesli bars which contain nuts. This is serious and can be life threatening for those children who have severe allergies. If you are unsure about any of this information, please ask class teachers for help.

To make good progress your child must attend school. Children with DLD need to have special teaching and learning programs. Your child must be at school every day to make sure the language outcomes are as successful as possible. We do encourage you to try to take any holidays within the allocated school holiday times. Missing several days of school does have an impact on children's learning. They miss out on new work, and it is sometimes difficult to catch up on this.

Only three weeks left this term. We finish the term on Thursday 28 March. School returns on Monday 15 April with both children and teachers starting on that day.




The focus expected behaviour for Week 9 is...
